DETECT & INTERRUPPT POTENTIALLY VIOLENT CONFLICTS

Trained violence interrupters & outreach workers prevent shootings by identifying & mediating potentially lethal conflicts in the community & following up to ensure that the conflict does not reignite.

2. IDENTIFY & TREAT HIGHEST RISK

Trained, culturally-appropriate outreach workers work with the highest risk to make them less likely to commit violence by meeting them where they are at, talking to them about the costs of using violence, & helping them to obtain the social services they need – such as job training & drug treatment.

3. MOBILIZE THE COMMUNITY TO CHANGE NORMS

Workers engage leaders in the communit as well as community residents, local bus ness owners, faith leaders, service providers, & the high risk, conveying the message that the residents, groups & the community do not support the use of violence.


