



The Rotary Club Turtle Trot



What's Happening in WHSD?

WOODLAND HILLS SCHOOL DISTRICT

To ensure the safety of staff and students during the ongoing renovations of Edgewood Elementary, the Woodland Hills School District has delayed the opening of the school until September 2.

Only Edgewood students and staff are impacted by this change. All other Woodland Hills students will start on Thursday, August 21 as scheduled.

The district is confident with the progress of the renovation process. This decision will minimize the disruptions to the school experience for both students and staff and will ensure their safety throughout the school day.

Along with the new September 2 start date, there are several additional changes to the calendar for Edgewood Elementary.

Pre-K and Kindergarten Orientation will now be held on Thursday, August 28. Kindergarten students will undergo orientation from 10 a.m. to 11 a.m. Transportation will be available for students. Pre-K students will undergo orientation from 11 a.m. to noon.

Edgewood will now have its Open House on Thursday, October 30. The district invites families and students to that event to see the renovations and meet with the Edgewood staff.

With the start of the new school year, the Woodland Hills School District is reminding all parents and guardians to make sure they have a PowerSchool account and that the contact information within PowerSchool is up to date. PowerSchool is an important resource for Woodland Hills families, as it contains information about grades, teacher communication, absence reporting, and access to forms and permissions.

To check on your account or sign up for a new one, please visit whsd.net, go to the Parents tab, and click on PowerSchool. The documentation there will guide parents and guardians through the registration and log-in process.

The Woodland Hills School District administration team has a new home. At its June agenda board meeting, the district's Board of School Directors formally approved a Letter of Intent for Heritage Community Initiatives to purchase the administration building at 531 Jones Avenue in North Braddock. The district has partnered with HCI for over four decades and it is thrilled that they're making additional investments in our community. As the district works with Heritage Community Initiatives to navigate the remainder of the process and to hopefully finalize the sale of the building, its facilities team has been busy relocating the administration team's operations to open space at the high school.

The move means all administration offices will be at the high school, including the Superintendent and Assistant Superintendents, special education, pupil personnel, buildings and grounds, the business office, human resources, information technology, and transportation. Phone numbers and emails for all of the administrators and personnel impacted by this move have remained the same. Signage will be in place at the entrance to the high school and throughout the campus, directing visitors to the entrance to the administration offices. Those offices will be located at the back of the high school building. Visitors will be able to use parking in the back.

Please note that all visitors will be required to have scheduled appointments with an administrator; walk-ins will not be permitted for security reasons during school hours. All board meetings will be held at the high school in the LGI Room for the time being. Please use the gymnasium entrance for board meetings.
