

ORDINANCE NO. 882

An Ordinance restricting the posting of handbills, placards, signs or advertisements upon poles or posts located upon the streets and public grounds in the Borough of Turtle Creek, prescribing penalty for violation, and repealing a prior ordinance.

The Borough of Turtle Creek hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, being the owner of any pole or post, located upon any of the streets, alleys, sidewalks or public grounds in the Borough of Turtle Creek, to post upon any such pole or post or to grant permission to any other person or persons, firm or corporation, to post thereon any handbill, sign, placard or advertisement of any kind. Any person or persons, firm or corporation, violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof before the Mayor or any Justice of the Peace of the Borough, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than ten (10) days. Provided: nothing contained herein shall be construed to prevent the posting or placing of any notice required by law or by order of court.

Section 2. Ordinance 297, April 18, 1911, and entitled: "An Ordinance prohibiting the posting of hand bills, placards, signs or advertisements upon telegraph poles or other poles in the Borough of Turtle Creek, or upon any public property belonging to the said Borough," is hereby repealed.
